Amendment & Referendums

State Constitutional Amendment: Vote ✓ ▶ NO

Photographic identification for voting. Shall section 1m of article III of the constitution be created to require that voters present valid photographic identification verifying their identity in order to vote in any election, subject to exceptions which may be established by law?

The amendment aims to enshrine Wisconsin's strict voter ID law into our constitution. It's important to know that Wisconsin's current voter ID law will still be in place whether or not this amendment is passed, and that this is simply an attempt by the state legislature to bypass the authority which belongs to our executive and judicial branches. It's critical that you, your family, & your friends **VOTE NO** so we can guarantee that each branch of government continues to maintain a system of checks and balances. Brookfield, City Municipal Referendum: Vote ✓YES

Under state law, the increase in the levy of the City of Brookfield for the tax to be imposed for the next fiscal year, 2026, is limited to 1.016%, which results in a levy of \$43,536,841. Shall the City of Brookfield be allowed to exceed this limit and increase the levy for the next fiscal year, 2026, for the purpose of maintaining City service levels, including police, fire, and emergency medical services staffing, road maintenance, and quality of life amenities, by a total of 13.781%, which results in a levy of \$49,536,841, and on an ongoing basis, include the increase of \$6,000,000 for each fiscal year going forward?

Vernon, Village Municipal Referendum: Vote ✓YES

Under state law, the increase in the levy of the Village of Vernon for the tax to be imposed for the next fiscal year, 2026 is limited to .887%, which results in a levy of \$2,200,098. Shall the Village of Vernon be allowed to exceed this limit and increase the levy for the next fiscal year, 2026, for the purpose of recruiting and retaining Paramedics/EMT's and firefighters to serve the Village of Vernon's Fire Department by a total of 31.817%, which results in a levy of \$2,900,098, and, on an ongoing basis, include the increase of \$700,000 for each fiscal year going forward?

Arrowhead Union High School Referendum: Vote ✓YES

QUESTION: Shall the Arrowhead Union High School District, Waukesha County, Wisconsin be authorized to issue pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Wisconsin Statutes, general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$136,200,000 for the public purpose of paying the cost of a school building and facility improvement project consisting of: construction of additions and renovations to the current North Campus building to consolidate into one high school building; demolition of the current South Campus building; site and athletic facility improvements; and acquisition of furnishings, fixtures, and equipment?

Lake Country School District School Referendum Vote ✓YES

QUESTION: Shall the Lake Country School District, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$800,000 per year for five years, beginning with the 2025-2026 school year and ending with the 2029-2030 school year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of operational expenses, including but not limited to maintaining curriculum programs, services, and rebuilding of the fund balance?
